When a power outage knocked IT systems offline for hours at Fidelity & Guaranty Life (FGL), a top-ranked annuity and life insurance provider, agents couldn't process customer applications. The downtime cost FGL, which serves 700,000 policy holders, tens of thousands of dollars.

In response, FGL replaced its prior Commvault system with a Dell EMC Data Protection solution to dramatically increase availability of business-critical workloads.

FGL uses Dell EMC RecoverPoint for Virtual Machines and Dell EMC Data Protection Software to provide disaster recovery (DR) of 200 virtual machines (VMs) between colocated data centers in Virginia and Texas. FGL runs Dell EMC Data Protection Software to back up to Dell EMC Data Domain appliances and Dell EMC Data Domain Cloud Tier software to back up data older than 60 days to a Virtustream cloud.

Environments protected by Dell EMC at FGL include Microsoft SQL Server, Microsoft Exchange, Oracle, SAP, financial applications, file shares and other workloads.

Keeping the revenue stream flowing

With a fast-growing virtualized environment, IT was consumed with high-maintenance DR testing. Not only did this impact IT productivity, but it also meant extended, painful recoveries of workloads if downtime occurred. That all changed when FGL switched to RecoverPoint for Virtual Machines.

Jeff Sabin, director of IT infrastructure, Fidelity & Guaranty Life, says, "We compete with firms offering similar products, so we need to differentiate by processing customer applications faster and running our business 24x7. With RecoverPoint for Virtual Machines, we've reduced our outage window from hours to minutes. That assures we can keep making money and serving customers during an outage or DR test."
